Applications are invited for the Chair in Health Management Strategies at the Institute of Health Policy, Management and Evaluation (IHPME), University of Toronto. The successful applicant will hold the Chair for a five-year term with the possibility of renewal. This is a key leadership role within. It is expected that the Chair will be held by an IHPME core faculty member.

The Chair was established in 2002 from a donation given by Liberty Health and matched by the University of Toronto. The successful candidate will have a vision and ability to establish a research program in health management and health systems. The Chair will be expected to: disseminate findings through scholarly journals; contribute to policy discussions and broader debate on health management; develop and teach specialized graduate courses; supervise graduate students and Post-Doctoral fellows; and contribute to the advancement of health management and health systems research. The Chair will also be expected to submit an annual report to the Director of IHPME and the Dean of Dalla Lana School of Public Health.

Attributes

The successful candidate will be a recognized scholar and tenured senior faculty member (at the Associate or Full Professor level) with expertise in health policy and health services organization and management. S/he will be a seasoned researcher with an excellent track record in establishing research programs, obtaining research funding, disseminating research outcomes, and reporting on research impact to stakeholders.
