Course title: **HAD5723H: Health Services Accounting**

#### Course Description:

HAD5723H is the first in a two-course sequence in health care financial management, intended to impart a foundation of accounting and finance knowledge necessary to manage health care organizations and make informed decisions. This first course introduces learners to managerial and financial accounting concepts.

#### Objectives:

In this course you will learn:

##### Financial Accounting:

- The types of financial reports required by organizations and the type of information in those financial statements.
- The theory and foundation of financial accounting and the 'rules' for the accumulation and reporting of financial information.
- Key financial performance measures and the interpretation of financial performance.

##### Managerial Accounting:

- The concepts and vocabulary in measuring costs, depending on the needs of the decision maker.
- The implications and use of management accounting tools and information for short term and long term decision making.
- Management accounting applications of forecasting, budgeting, and variance analysis.

##### Performance Analysis:

- Perform a performance analysis of a chosen health care organization using financial and managerial information from provincial datasets.



**Qualifications:**

- A PhD or Masters level with experience in operation, planning, and funding of health services;
- A robust understanding of accounting principles and health care financial management;
- Past teaching experience related to health care financial management, preferably at the graduate level
- Prior experience in curriculum development and adult teaching-learning methods;
- Comfortable with electronic teaching tools such as Learning Management Systems (e.g., Blackboard), PowerPoint, as well as on-line collaboration tools (Blogs, Wikis, Discussion Boards, Webinars, or Video-conferencing).
