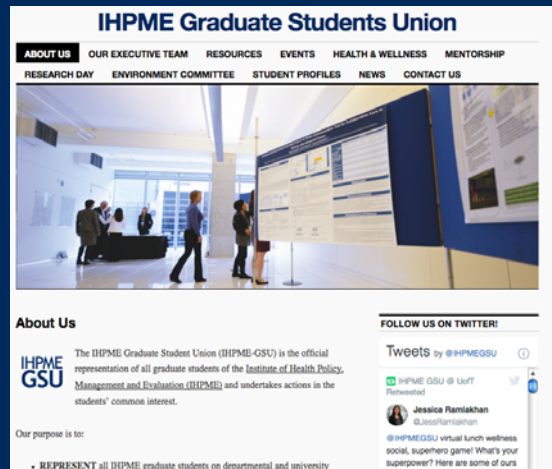


IHPME GSU Accomplishments

Growth & efficiency

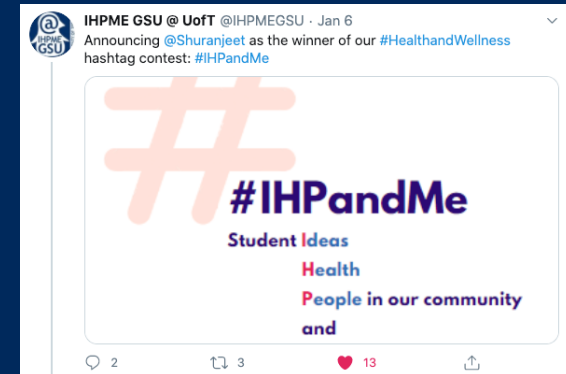
- Over 40 GSU reps (one of the largest GSU until date)

Student Health & Wellness




- Implemented new Health & Wellness Lead role
